

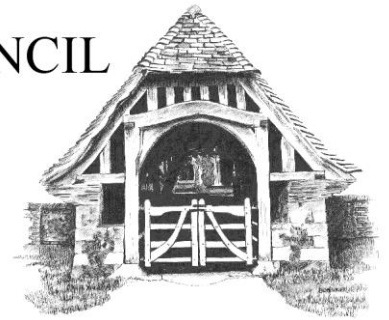

Maggi Bevan stressed that the RBWM online JADU system for reporting is open to all and that instructions for use are on the website.</p> <p>A member if the public raised the issue of Bears Copse WSL where several trees have had their branches removed which will cause them to die, all related to planning application 17/03542. (Single storey side/rear extension and new garage/store and work room following demolition of the two existing detached garages and conservatory). 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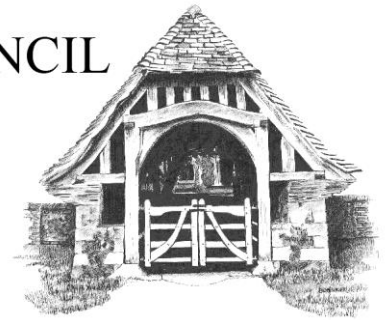

The Parish Council agreed that although not required for the Internal Audit purpose (PK LittleJohn), figures should be published to comply with the Transparency code for Bank Reconciliation, Variances vs previous year, Reconciliation of and Boxes 7 and 8. Clerk to obtain from RFO and publish. The Chairman raised the issue of tidying up the edges of the Burial Ground and will raise this with ANB Groundcare as an Autumn tidy up. The Chairman asked for confirmation that a <i>Recharge has been made to The Neville Hall for Insurance, the Clerk confirmed this will be in the next 'payment in'.</i></p>	<p>Clerk Chairman Clerk</p>
<p>FC/7/407/2018</p>	<p>Reports from Representatives: Report from the Clerk: the issue with the Livery Stables in Shurlock Row appears to have gone away. Communications: M Bevan stressed the need for us to be as open as possible. Bridleways and Footpaths: There was confusion as to whether we knew that BCA were due to do some clearing, this may have been due to the fact it came out as a Highways piece of communication rather than Bridleways, like wise Neville Close was inadvertently allocated to Highways. Certain Footpaths need to be considered going forward re clearing, though it is likely this will be a Highways issue and thus needs reporting through JADU. Highways: It has been confirmed there will be new signage at the junction of Halls Lane/Broadmoor Road regarding HGV traffic New SMART Motorway work is accepted as a fait accompli. Chairman to continue chasing Andy Jeffs on lack of RBWM communication on works planned. Burial Ground: No requirement for highlighting to the PC when a service is happening, however Clerk and M Hipgrave need to be aware of when services are happening to ensure that the Burial Ground is looking its best. Rose Garden will be updated, with sympathy to what is already there. K Sarsfield liaising with interested parties. A new proposal is required by September, a new donor has come forward to help, the Parish Council will also to be involved. Chairman has briefed ANB re chain that needs removal from a tree. Signpost also needs replacing which needs to be applied for through JADU Further assurances have been received that the Pond at Shurlock Row will be cleared very soon. There are also to be 2 benches to be installed. Dog Poo Bin emptying proposal received from Nick Kohl, payment for this should be made to the Village Charities.
