Planning Applications:

14/03759: 4 Fourcroft Cottages, Waltham St Lawrence The Parish Council still maintain their objection to his application on grounds of over development and the balcony is deemed to create overlooking to other residents of the road

14/03893/03894: Bears Copse West End

The Parish Council object to these applications as they stand because of the removal of timbered columns, thereby damaging the integrity of the building, and we would wish to see the deletion of the 1 roof light on the older part as this is unnecessary in agricultural terms.

If the officer is minded to approve these applications we wish to see a condition that the use of the barn should be ancillary to the main house

14/03810: Orchard House, Waltham St Lawrence

The Parish Council strongly object to this application and would be astonished that if those responsible do not consider that as it stands this application is contrary to GB2, where this development has a greater impact on openness, NPPF as a disproportionate increase and CA2 (2) which requires the protection of views that contribute to the distinctive character of the Conservation Area

The key question is 'does it enhance or preserve the character or appearance of the area?' It is our considered view that it does not

If the officers are minded to approve we would wish to be sure that the roofline on the proposed extension will be as shown on the architects plan 2165/PL/104 and no higher in relation to Orchard House and not Orchard Cottage and deletion of the glazed link which is totally alien to this Special Conservation Area; and that this extension should be subservient to the main house and not disposed of separately

14/03895: Paddocks, Waltham St Lawrence

The Parish Council strongly object to this application on grounds of GB2 and CA (2) and it conflicts with NPPF para 89 test ' is it disproportionate to the size of the original building'? Answer YES
