M4 Junctions 8/9 to 10 Straight Mile Bridge – Maintenance Scheme

I am writing to advise that Kier Highways, on behalf of Highways England, will be undertaking essential repairs to the bridge which carries The Straight Mile over the M4, to ensure it remains in a safe and serviceable condition. Activities will involve replacing the joints and waterproofing material beneath the carriageways, then resurfacing across the bridge deck.

The work is currently scheduled to start on Thursday 1 February 2018 and is expected to take up-to two weeks to complete.

In order to carry out the work as efficiently and safely as possible, we will fully close the bridge over the M4 overnight (Monday to Friday only); a clearly signed diversion will be in place via The Straight Mile, B3018 and Forest Road.

Please be aware that these works have been carefully programmed but are subject to change due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances – **confirmation of the dates/timings of the bridge closures will be displayed in advance on the Straight Mile.**

We would like to apologise in advance for any inconvenience or disruption during our work. We will make every effort to manage noise levels to minimise the local impact.
