	<p>Public Question Time: A member of the public asked whether the posts outside The Neville Hall could be updated whilst the Pound is being renovated.</p> <p>A member of the public asked whether an area of the grave yard could be turned over to a wild life area in an effort to save money, the Chairman commented that overall maintenance was under tighter financial control now, but that it would be investigated.</p> <p>A member of the public questioned whether the Milley Road play area would be handed back once the Nature Reserve commenced, also what would be happening regarding the network Rail area when the work is completed. The Chairman commented that a small yard will be retained by Network Rail. This will be monitored as the Network Rail project comes to completion.</p> <p>Councillor Hunt provided 10 copies of Neighbourhood Plan for distribution amongst others to The Preservation Society and Parish Council members. Councillor Hunt also advised that a Draft Borough Plan has been issued, a decision date is TBC. There is now an approved computer system for recording reported issues which will ensure that they are addressed to the correct department. The Parish Council are investigating this system which is in its infancy. Maggi Bevan and Clerk to report back when there are more details. The three areas of main concern for speeding appear to be Broadmoor Road, Shurlock Road and Milley Bridge. Chairman commented that the 40mph sign over Milley Bridge is illegible, additionally there was a query over signage at the Memorial being incorrectly aligned. 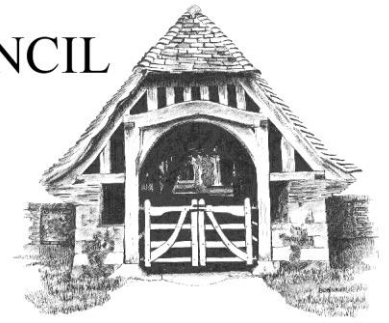

Alternative sites were also discussed, Further conversation and investigation required before approval to proceed. Vehicular access (at low cost) is another consideration.</p> <p>Shurlock Inn Defibrillator and Shurlock Row Pond: The Chairman confirmed that 2 options were available Buy and Insure and maintain Management Agreement for 4 years (insured and maintained)</p> <p>There was no apparent cost differential. Parish Council agreed the 4 year Managed option should be sought.
