### Recipe Cake - Class 8 - Apple Cake

225g self-raising flour 225g caster sugar ½ tsp almond extract

250g cooking apples, peeled,

cored and thickly sliced

1 level tsp baking powder

2 large eggs

150g butter, melted 25g flaked almonds

Preheat the oven to 160C/fan 140C/gas 3.

Lightly grease a deep 20cm loose-bottomed cake tin. MIx the flour, baking powder, sugar, eggs, almond extract and melted butter into a bowl until blended, then beat for a minute. Spread half this mixture in to the tin. Lay the apple slices on top of the mixture in the tin. Roughly spoon the remaining mixture over the apples, covering the centre as it will spread out in the oven. Sprinkle with the flaked almonds. Bake in preheated oven for 1½-1½ hours until golden and coming away from the sides of the tin.
